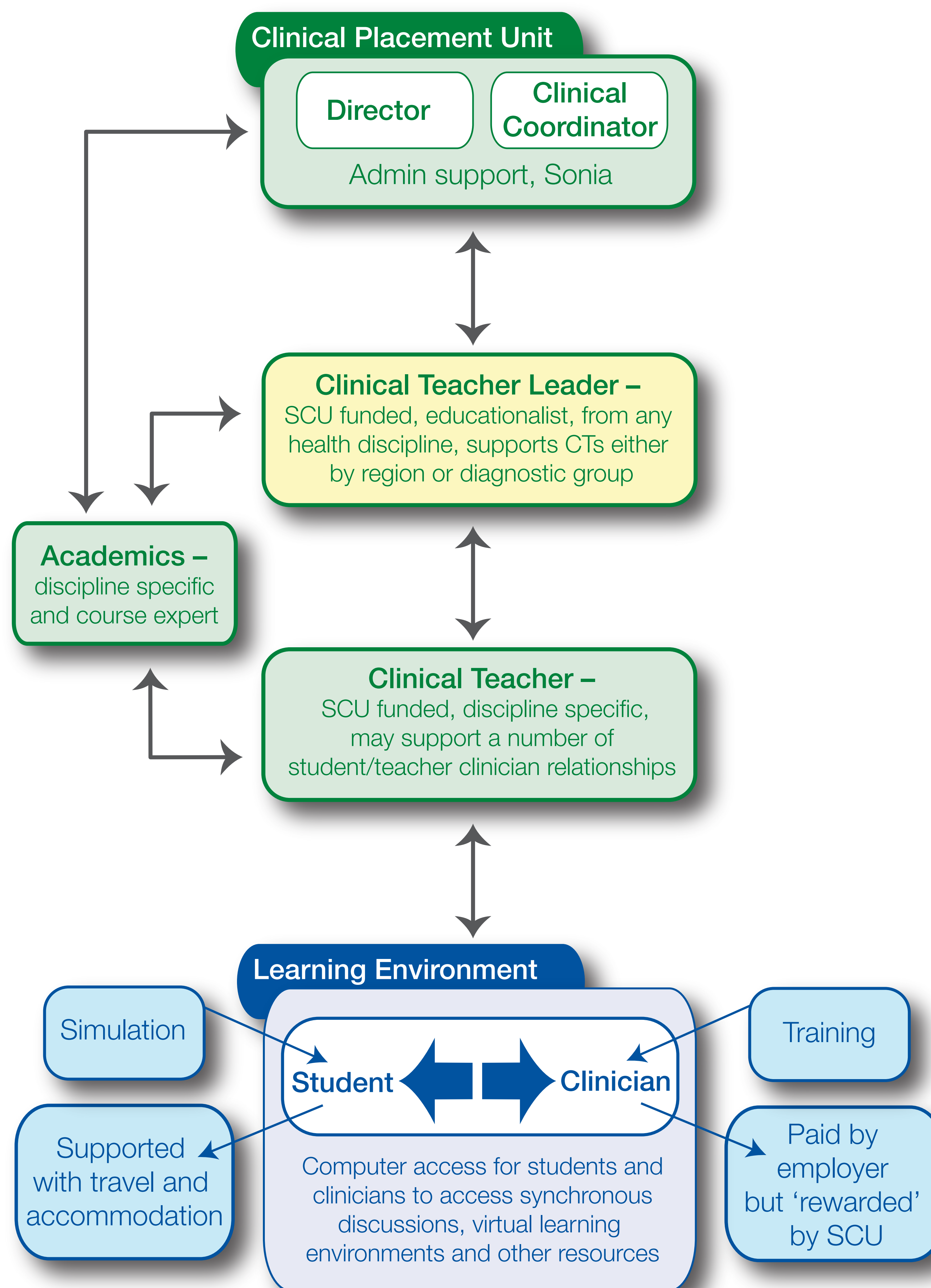
Creating Innovative Partnerships to Improve Clinical Nursing Education
